



3.4.3 Number of extension and outreach programs conducted by the institution through organized forums including NSS/NCC with involvement of the community during the last five years.

The institute wish to formally appeal for the **re-evaluation of Metric 3.4.3 – Number of Extension and Outreach Programs Conducted** by the institution, specifically during the Re-DVV process.

Key Points for Consideration:

- **HEI Input:** The institute had submitted details of 60 **extension and outreach programs** conducted by the institute through student committees and involvement of community during the assessment period 2018–2023 with all the supporting documents as per SOP.
- **DVV Findings:** Provide links/uploads of photographs (preferably with banners) and any other supporting documents of relevance.
- **DVV Accepted:** After our initial response, **44 extension and outreach programs were accepted** during the DVV process.
- **Re-DVV Reduction:** However, during the Re-DVV stage, **only 24 activities** have been considered, which reflects a considerable reduction. **It has brought down the score from 4 to 3.**

Clarification:

- All reported activities were conducted **for the benefit of the community**, not just the student body.
- These were **student-led initiatives** focusing on **community service, awareness drives, and social welfare**, fully aligned with the intent of NAAC's evaluation framework.

Supporting Evidence:

- The institute has submitted **detailed event reports, participation records, and photographs** clearly showing the **community beneficiaries** and impact of these extension & outreach programs.
- These documents support our claim of conducting **more 40 relevant extension and outreach programs**, which should meet the **highest benchmark under metric 3.4.3.**

Request:

- The institute **request the restoration of our score from 3 to 4**, based on our strict adherence to the SOP and the comprehensive documentation previously accepted.
