

Rule 15 – Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fees, Return of Documents by Institutions Cancellation of Admission and Refund of fees, return of documents by Institutions.—

- 1. (a) The Candidate shall apply online for cancellation and submit duly signed copy of system generated application for cancellation of admission to the institution. Once the candidate submits online request for cancellation, his admission shall be treated as cancelled. The Institute shall consider the online request made by Candidate for cancellation as final irrespective of whether he has submitted duly signed copy of system generated application to the institute. Upon such cancellation, the candidate shall lose the claim on the seat and such seat shall become available for further allotment. The candidate shall then become entitled to and the Institute shall refund the entire fees to the candidate after deduction of Rs.1000/- towards processing charges and return all his original documents submitted to the institute within two days from submission of duly signed copy of system generated application to the institute;
- 2. (b) Notwithstanding clause (a) above, candidate shall not be entitled to any refund of his fee except the Security Deposit and Caution Money Deposit if the online cancellation is effected by the candidate after 5.00 p.m. of the cut-off date prescribed by the Competent Authority;
- 3. (c) No Institution, who has in its possession or custody, of any document in the form of certificates of degree, diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, shall refuse to return such degree, certificate award or other document with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such person does not intend to pursue or avail any facility in such institution.
- 4. (d) The institution shall not entitle to recover the fees for the subsequent years from the student seeking cancellation of his admission at any point of time.".

"For MBA First Year: **100% admissions are... on the basis of non-zero positive score** in one of the following: CET (MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2024), CAT, or other such recognised exam."

**In practice:** The main criterion is the CET score (or other recognised test) and the qualifying graduation marks. The brochure for 2024 mentions eligibility of 50% (45% for reserved) in graduation.

**From exam pattern sources:** The CET exam for MBA has 200 marks (Logical Reasoning, Abstract Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, Verbal Ability & Reading Comprehension) with no negative marking.

  - Graduation eligibility: At least 50% marks (or equivalent) in a three-year Bachelor's degree (any discipline) for general category; 45% for backward class / EWS / PwD candidates of Maharashtra state. CET Cell

  - For the MCA CET test pattern: The exam has 100 questions, total 200 marks (e.g., 30 questions in Maths & Statistics (60 marks), 30 in Logical/Abstract Reasoning (60 marks), 20 in English (40 marks), 20 in Computer Concepts (40 marks)).
